## Creating Public Value Through Aligned Leadership

Most school boards are structured for governance.

Policies. Procedures. Oversight.

But structure alone does not determine effectiveness.

What ultimately shapes a board's **impact is alignment**—  
alignment around vision, purpose, and **how leaders work together**.

## The Board's Role vs. The Board's Purpose

### Role (Structural — What Boards Do)

- Approve policies
- Oversee the superintendent
- Ensure compliance
- Manage budgets and resources

### Purpose (Relational — Why Boards Exist)

- Create public value for students and community
- Align around a shared vision
- Provide clear and unified direction
- Build trust across leadership

A board can fulfill its role and still fall short of its purpose.

## The Reality

Board members typically begin with:

- ✓ Strong commitment to their community
- ✓ A desire to make a difference
- ✓ A clear sense of purpose

But over time, many boards experience:

- ⊙ Misalignment between members
- ⊙ Tension with district leadership
- ⊙ Breakdown in trust and communication
- ⊙ Formation of factions

Self-protection replacing mission protection.

# What We're Seeing Across Leadership Research

Across public sector and organizational leadership research, several **consistent themes** emerge:



**Alignment** drives performance and **clarity**



**Trust** is essential for effective decision-making



**Fragmentation** at the **leadership level**  
reduces system-wide effectiveness



**Strong board**—superintendent **alignment** is critical



High-performing systems focus on creating **public value**—  
not just managing process

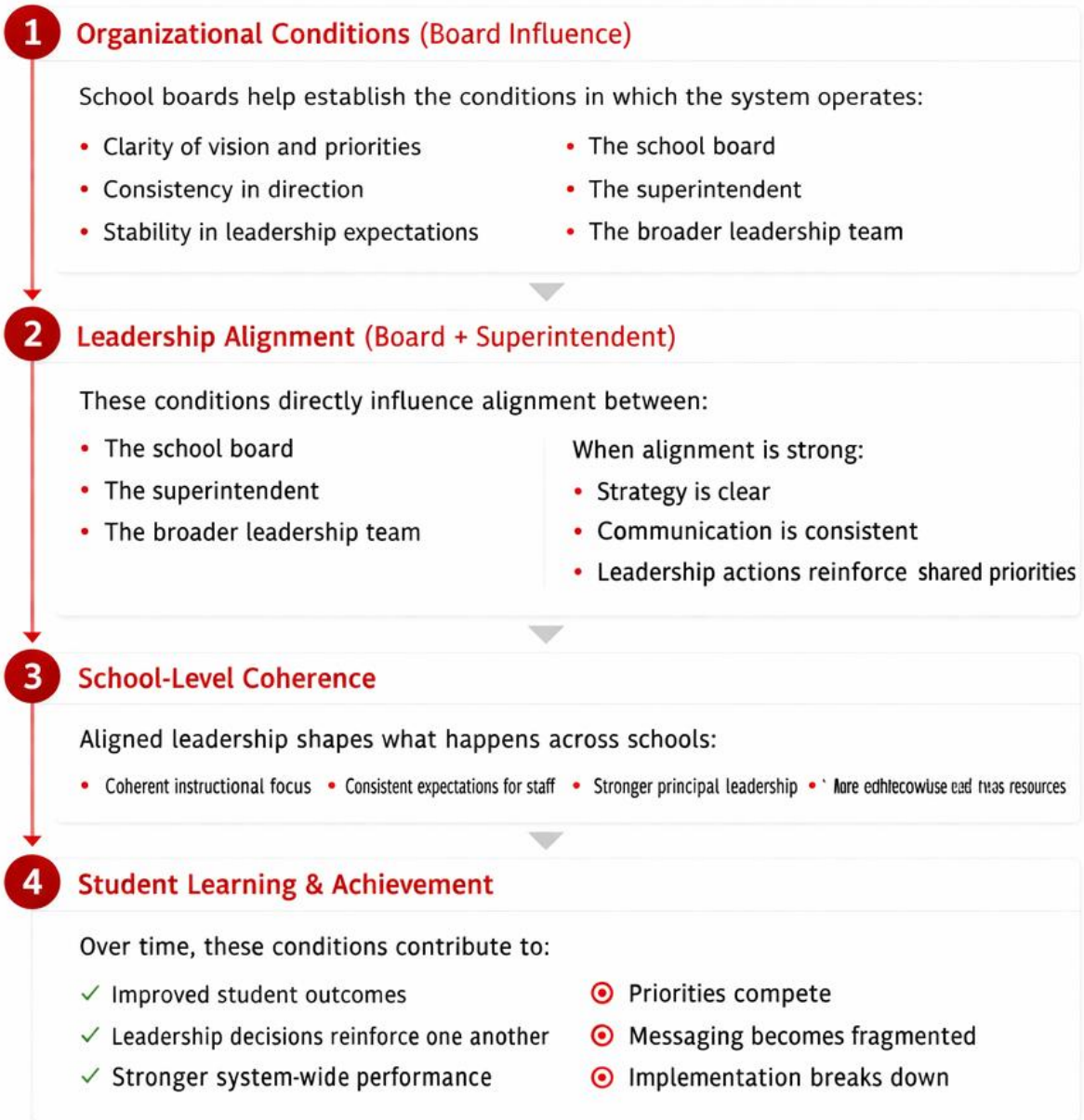
These findings reinforce a clear conclusion:

# How Leadership Alignment Impacts Student Outcomes

School boards do not **influence** student learning directly. Their impact is **mediated**—shaped through the **conditions they create** and the **alignment** they establish within the system.

## The Pathway of Impact



**Key Insight:** School boards shape student outcomes indirectly—but powerfully. Not through individual decisions alone, but through the conditions and alignment they create across the system.
